**ORDER DISSOLVING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER  
AND DENYING PLAINTIFF’S REQUEST FOR A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

---

THIS MATTER came before the Court on *Plaintiff, Health Advance Inc.’s motion for Preliminary Injunction* (ECF No.3), and *Defendant, Jordan Starkman’s Motion to Dissolve Temporary Restraining Order* (ECF No. 23.) The Court, being fully advised, FINDS:

1. On August 4, 2017, Plaintiff Health Advance filed this lawsuit against Jordan Starkman. (*See Verified Complaint*, ECF No. 1).
2. Plaintiff also sought and was granted a temporary restraining order, *as amended*, against Mr. Starkman on August 7, 2017. (*See Motion for TRO*, ECF No. 3; *TRO*, ECF No. 6; *Motion to Amend TRO*, ECF No.14; & *Amended TRO*, ECF No. 19).
3. On September 7, 2017, Defendant Jordan Starkman filed *Defendant Jordan Starkman’s Motion to Dissolve Temporary Restraining Order* pursuant to Rule 65(b)(4) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
4. After evidentiary hearing, reviewing and considering the various filings by the Parties and after weighing the four (4) factors for injunctive relief discussed by the Tenth Circuit in *Awad v. Ziriax*, 670 F.3d 1111, 1125 (10th Cir. 2012), the Court finds goods cause exists to

dissolve the August 7, 2017 ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, ECF No. 6, *as amended*, and to deny Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction.

5. This Court incorporates by reference herein its oral findings of fact and conclusions of law made on the record at the conclusion of the evidentiary hearing on Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Motion to Dissolve Temporary Restraining Order, on September 12, 2017.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that *Defendant Jordan Starkman's Motion to Dissolve Temporary Restraining Order* is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court's August 7, 2017 ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, ECF No. 6, *as amended*, is DISSOLVED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction is DENIED.
